Report of Commissioners to the Board, made in pursuance of an order of this Board, at
November Term 1844 to which there is no exception and the Court concurring
said Report doth adjudge and decree that unto Nancy Gay & Wedderburn Waller
George and Sarah Gay or some one for them shall owe before the 1st
day of January 1847 pay to Alexander Fairbank the sum of thirty nine
dollars & twenty cents with interest one thirty two dollars and Ninety three
cents paid therof from January 1st 1842 to George W. Wedderburn twenty
six dollars and sixty eight cents with interest from 7th January 1842 to
twenty dollars and thirty eight cents to Thomas and Adams thirty one dollars
and thirty two cents with interest from 28th May 1842 to Alfred S. Brinck
nineteen dollars and forty four cents with interest 10th August 1843 to George
Gay twenty seven dollars and sixty seven cents with interest from 10th
September 1843 and to A. Atherton four dollars due to Sheriff of
Southampton who is appointed a Commissioner for this purpose shall after giving
thirty day notice of the time & place of sale of advertisement at the last
house door of the town on some convenient day and at two or three places in
the neighborhood of the land set on the premises to the highest bidder one
third of twelve months next come sufficient to pay the cost of the sale and
expenses of sale all the land of which George Gay doth object that he
take lands under tenacity of the purchase and return the like all the
purchase money is paid and that the Report be forwarded to County
Court the court doth adjudge and decree that a Commissioner of
