

Rockwell and the other sea party they deliver to the defendant Martha Rockwell That if the said Commissioners cannot effect said discharge in time they are hereby authorized and required after giving reasonable notice of the time and place of sale to sell at public auction for cash money on many of said slaves as may be necessary for that purpose and out of the proceeds of such sale pay unto the plaintiff above before and unto the defendant John W. Rockwell such an amount not more equal to one eighth of the value of the whole number of said slaves having previously paid the expenses of such sale and if any balance remain in their hands they are hereby directed to pay the same to the defendant Martha Rockwell and make Report of their proceedings to Court and the Court further orders that as to all other matters this case be continued till the next Term

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning ten o'clock
