This day this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read, and on
the report of Commissioner held made in pursuance of an order of the Court pronounced
at November Term 1846, to which report there is no exception, and was argued by
Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth further order that the said report doth adjudicate,
order and decree that David Grizzard administrator of John L. Barham deceased,
deliver to Martha J. Barham the slave in the proceedings mentioned to wit, Jordan
and Lucy to be held by her during her natural life, with remainder in fee simple
to Gordon Barham and William Barham - And the Court doth further order
and decree that the said David Grizzard administrator is of record pay to
Martha J. Barham the sum of Nine Dollars and fifty cents with interest from
1st day of January 1846 till paid - And the Court doth further adjudicate, order and
decree that David Grizzard administrator of Lazarus Barham and Georgiana
Barham pay to Martha J. Barham the sum of Twelve hundred and ten dollars
and twenty cents with interest from 1st day of May 1847, being the balance
due from him as administrator of said Lazarus Barham and Georgiana
Barham deceased - But the said Martha J. Barham, is not to have the
benefit of this decree against David Grizzard administrator of Lazarus Bara-
ham and Georgiana Barham until she shall enter into Bond with one or
more sufficient securities with the Clerk's office of this Court with the penalty of
Three Thousand Six hundred and Sixty Five dollars and forty six cents conditioned
to pay at her death to Gordon Barham and William Barham the sum of
Twelve Hundred and ten Dollars and twenty cents with interest thereon from
1st May 1847, provided however, that the estate of the said Martha J. Barham
after her death shall not be bound to pay to the said Gordon Barham
and William Barham, more than Eight hundred and thirty three dollars
and twenty three cents with interest from the time of her death - And the Court
doth further order that this decree be suspended, until Martha J. Barham
shall execute to David Grizzard a refunding bond with sufficient security
with the penalty of Two thousand four hundred and twenty Dollars and forty
cents conditioned to refund her due proportion of any debts, which may be
recovered against the estate of John L. Barham and the costs of such recovery -
And the Court doth further adjudicate, order and decree that David Grizzard
out of the interest which he holds which has accrued on the sum of Twelve hun-
dred and ten dollars and twenty cents, since 1st day of January 1846, pay the
expenses and costs of this suit -
