thereon at the rate of six per centum per annum from September
30th 1845 till paid. And the Court doth further adjudged order
and decree that the said Eber Gott pay to William O'Dinegron
the sum of seven hundred and twenty dollars and sixty seven
cents with interest from 30th September 1845 till paid subject
to a credit for the sum of five hundred and twenty seven dollars
and forty cents paid on 15th day of March 1847 to Ormsa Balle
executive of Francis P Balle and late guardian to William O
Dinegron And that the defendants pay to the plaintiffs their
costs expensed in this suit And liberty is reserved to the
plaintiffs to ask for further relief against the other defendants if
the decree should prove unavailing against the defendant Eber
Gott
