The defendant in this cause having been reconstituted on the defendants and two months having elapsed as well since the service of the suit process as since the plaintiff filed their bill, on motion of the plaintiff the Court will take their bill for confounded as to all the defendants and the cause comes at this day to be heard as the bill exhibits filed and statement filed marked (D) and was argued by counsel on consideration whereof and by consent of parties the Court doth adjudge order and direct that, said Cobb pay to the plaintiff Mary V Dinguird the sum of seven hundred and twenty dollars and eighty seven cents with interest thereon at the rate of six per centum per annum from September 30<sup>th</sup> 1845 till paid and the court doth further adjudge order and direct that the said Cobb pay to William D Dinguird the sum of seven hundred and twenty dollars and forty seven cents with interest from 20<sup>th</sup> September 1845 till paid subject to a credit for the sum of five hundred and twenty seven dollars and forty cents paid on 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1847 to Clement Bulle executor of Francis P Bulle and late Guardian to William D Dinguird and that the defendant pay to the plaintiff their costs expended in this suit and liberty is reserved to the plaintiff to ask for further relief against the other defendants if the decree should prove unavailing against the defendant, said Cobb.

This cause came on again to be heard in the papers formerly run together with the report of the Commissioner made pursuant to the several order of May Term 1848 and the deposition accompanying the same and the exceptions taken by the defendant to the said report and was argued by counsel on consideration whereof the Court overruling said exceptions and considering full report done, adjudge order and direct that the plaintiff recover of the defendant as Executor of Clements Rockelle the sum of eight thousand three hundred and seven dollars eighty six cents with interest thereon from October the 1<sup>st</sup> 1845 till paid, to be levied of the goods and chattels of the testator in the hands of the said Sparks to be administered and the costs of this suit are to be paid equally by the plaintiff and the defendant Executor aforesaid out of the goods and chattels of the testator in his hands to be administered.
