This day this cause came on to be finally heard on the papers formerly read in and on the report of Commissioner Goodwyn made under an order of this Court pronounced at November Term 1845 to which report there is no exception, and the Court confirming said report doth adjudge order and decree that William J. Goodwyn out of the money in his hands pay to Peter J. Adams the sum of One hundred and nineteen dollars ninety four cents with interest from 8th of November 1847. To Nicholas J. Bradens administrator of his wife Priscilla the sum of thirty nine dollars & ninety eight cents with like interest. To John Southall and Polly his wife Jacob Thomas Sheriff of Southampton Committee of the estate of Elizabeth A. Branch Goodwyn & Griffin Committee of Peter South, and Patrick D. Rollins administrator of Ann Rollings Edwards Burke administrator of Martha Morris John B. Booth and William Beale each the sum of five dollars twenty one cents with like interest. To James Adams and Hannah his wife John & Warren John C. Nicholson administrator of Susan Faison, William White administrator of his deceased wife Diana, William J. Corvett Sheriff and administrator of Peter W. Warner and Elijah D. Merrill & Salia his wife each the sum of Six dollars and sixty six cents with like interest. And the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that the parties each pay the costs by them expended in this suit.

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This day this cause came on again to be heard upon the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Goodwyn made pursuant to the order of May Term 1847 to which no exception has been filed and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court confirming said report doth order, adjudge and decree that the defendant James B. Barnes pay unto the plaintiff John B. Bishop the sum of One hundred and ninety seven dollars and seventy six cents with interest thereon from the first day of January in the year 1844 till paid together with the costs of this suit. And Liberty is thereby reserved to the plaintiff to proceed against the other defendants in the cause should this decree prove unavailing.
