Bartons administrator of his wife Priscilla the sum of thirty nine dollars and ninety eight cents with like interest - To John Southall and Polly his wife Jacob Barnes Sheriff of Southampton & Committee of the estate of Elizabeth A. Branch Goodwyn J. Griffin Committee of Peter Booth, Jacob Abbott & Rollings administrator of Am't Rollings Edwards Butts administrator of Martha Morris, John St. Booth and William Beale each the sum of five dollars twenty one cents with like interest - To James Holmes and Hannah his wife Shaw & Warren John C. Nicholson administrator of Susan Faison Wilkins White am't of his deceased wife Diana, William S. Everett Sheriff and administrator of Peter H. Warren and Elizab. D. Merrell & wife his wife each the sum of Six dollars and Sixty six cents with like interest and the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that the parties each pay the costs by them expended in this suit.
