It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that two months have elapsed as well since the plaintiff's filed their bill, as since the service of the subpoena on the defendant Nicholas Dayant who still failing to appear and answer on the motion of the plaintiff their bill is taken for confessed as to this defendant And the cause came on to be heard on the bill answers of the other defendants replications thereto and exhibits and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Nicholas Dayant render before a Commissioner of this Court an account of his transactions as late guardian to Leonard Gray formerly Louis O'Dayant - that the Commissioner return said account to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which may be required by the parties to be so stated. And as to all other matters this cause is continued, the Court expressing no opinion as to the liability of the guardian's securities.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning Eleven o'clock.
