 thereof and whether they severally primarily binds the Real estate

 Rochelle dead in doing which he will consider the authorities handed in
 the Plaintiff bill as prima facie correct subject to be overcharged and
 satisfied by the plaintiff or any other creditor and the said Commission
 will ascertain what portion of the debts of the testator paid off by the
 executor binds the Real estate of the said Clement Rochelle as
 particular statement of which he will annex to his Report. 3^d He
 will ascertain what Real estate the said Clement Rochelle died seized
 and possessed of where situated and its annual and for simple value
 and in doing this he will report each tract of land and as near
 as he can its quantity and particular boundaries all which he will
 report to Court with such matters as he may deem pertinent to be
 specially stated or which either party may require to be so stated
