of September next pay to John Hines the sum of thirty six dollars and
thirteen cents with interest on twenty seven dollars and thirty cents paid thereof
from February 10th 1837 to Elijah Davis the sum of two hundred and forty
four dollars and sixty eight cents with interest on two hundred and twenty six
dollars and twelve cents paid thereof from the day the first to 8th October
the sum of Ninety dollars and forty cents with interest thereof from May
the 7th 1842 to Robert Hinchliffe the sum of twenty two dollars and
eighty two cents with interest on twenty dollars from September the 3^d 1842
to the same the sum of two dollars and forty eight cents with interest from
December the 16th 1837 to D. Ditham White the sum of twenty dollars
with interest from April the 1^d 1838 to Mary Carroll the sum of
fourteen dollars and thirty one cents with interest from June the 15th 1838
to Carroll Hancock the sum of three dollars and eighteen cents with
interest from June the 15th 1838 to Eliza Carroll the sum of twelve
dollars and thirty eight cents with interest on six dollars from April
1st 1836 and on six dollars from May the 9th 1838 to Mathew
Prest the sum of fifty seven dollars and thirty four cents with interest
from the 31st of August 1846 to Peter L. Stapp administrator of John
Darguer the sum of thirty one dollars and twenty one cents with interest
on thirty dollars from August the 31st 1846 to Robert Dick
Executor of William Riche the sum of eighty four dollars and forty
cents with interest on fifty dollars and six cents with interest from
the September 12th 1835 to John Doster the sum of forty two
dollars and thirty four cents with interest on thirty seven dollars
and thirty seven cents from December the 20th 1834 to James Blayford
