 of September Term pay to John Hines the sum of thirty six dollars and
 thirteen cents with interest on twenty seven dollars and thirty cents paid thereof
 from February 23^d 1837 to Elijah Davis the sum of two hundred and forty
 four dollars and sixty eight cents with interest on two hundred and twenty six
 dollars and twelve cents paid thereof from the day till paid to P. H. Hollings
 the sum of thirteen dollars and forty cents with interest thereof from May
 the 7th 1842 to John Birruch the sum of twenty two dollars and
 eighty two cents with interest on twenty dollars from September the 3^d 1842
