So the return on the said execution as amended reads thus "Satisfied by Thos B Norvell adm<sup>r</sup> of Lewis Norvell dec<sup>d</sup>."

interest at six dollars and eighty six cents from January the 1<sup>st</sup> 1845 and  
on thirty four dollars from February the 1<sup>st</sup> 1846 To James Sachse  
two dollars and eighty two cents with interest at two dollars and twenty two  
cents from January the 3<sup>d</sup> 1846 To C D Backman sixty five dollars  
with interest at four cents from January the 1<sup>st</sup> 1846 Reilly Surgeon twenty two  
dollars and fifty cents with interest from January 1<sup>st</sup> 1844 Pampson  
to Rorer thirty three dollars and twenty three cents with interest at fourteen  
dollars and eighty eight cents from January 1<sup>st</sup> 1845 and on fourteen  
dollars and twenty one cents from January 3<sup>d</sup> 1846 Henry Hinders fourteen  
dollars and sixty seven cents with interest from June the 30<sup>th</sup> 1843 To S J  
P Backman thirty two dollars and fifty six cents with interest at twenty  
two dollars from March 17<sup>th</sup> 1847 To Lewis Durr eleven dollars and fifty  
one cents with interest at two dollars and three cents from January 3<sup>d</sup>  
1845 Benjamin C Daddis fifteen dollars and fourteen cents with  
interest at fourteen dollars and seven cents from January 3<sup>d</sup> 1846  
To Joseph I Pike eleven dollars and thirteen cents with interest from  
the 1<sup>st</sup> of February 1845 then James Parker Robert Parker and  
Charles Cornish who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose  
shall proceed to assign to Martha Berth or some one in value of  
the same in the proceedings mentioned as above and the Court doth  
further decree that Joseph I Pike pay to William I Schell  
who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner of the Court for the
