Plaintiff this day filed his bill in court praying for an injunction
against the defendant until it is brought adjudged and deserved that
upon the plaintiff a sum not far ^{from} exceeding as laid in the like
Office of this Court in the penalty of one hundred dollars with
security who shall justify out such as to his sufficiency conditioned to pay
and satisfy the defendant all such costs shall be adjudged recovered

selling the slave Dick living Albert and Sam in the bill mentioned
until the further order of this Court and the Sheriff of this Court is
ordered to take into his possession the said slaves and his share out
and return to Court the bonds taken for their hire But in case the
said George P. Nicholson or some one for him shall enter into bond with
security who shall justify out such as to his or their sufficiency on the
penalty of fifteen hundred dollars payable to the plaintiff conditioned
to have the said slaves forthcoming to abide any demand that may be
made in this Court and pay and satisfy the plaintiff whatever may be
awarded to him in this Court the Sheriff will return the said slaves
to the defendant, Nicholson and return the said bonds to the Court

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning 1st of Oct
