To Elizabeth Glauz nine hundred and sixty six dollars and seventy seven cents with like interest. To ~~Elizabeth~~ Glauz the like sum with like interest. To Rosa S. Glauz the like sum with like interest and the Court doth further assign order and decrees that the costs of this suit be paid equally by all the parties.
