On consideration whereof the Court being of opinion that on consequence of the relation that existed between the plaintiff and the defendants and of the peculiar mental sensibility and depression of spirit under which the former labored and was suffering at the time the deed and bond in the bill referred to were executed each bearing date on the 18 day of November 1843 ought to be set aside with judgment order and decree that the said deed and bond be and the same are hereby declared null and void and the Court shall further signify order and decree that the Commissioners of this Court take an account of the dealings and transactions between the said plaintiff and the said Defendants since the execution of the said deed showing the amount of the ^{real} profits and hire of the slaves & other property conveyed by the deed aforesaid to the defendants together with the amount money received and paid since the execution of the said by the said defendants for or on account of the said plaintiff which account the ^{said} Commissioners is directed to examine take and Report with any matters which he may deem pertinent or which may be required by the parties to be so stated.
