 and sixty seven cents with like interest To Selah Simmons one
 hundred and two dollars and seventy cents with like interest
 To Benjamin Hines sixteen dollars and fifty two cents with like
 interest To Samuel J. Samu seventeen dollars and seventy one
 cents with like interest To Henry Hines thirty seven dollars and
 thirty three cents with like interest To D. H. Simmons two dollars
 and eleven cents with like interest To J. H. Simmons two dollars
 and twenty one cents with like interest To J. H. Simmons two dollars

 further order and decree that the Commissioner of the Court make
 statement of the amount still due to the above named plaintiffs
 taking the same due upon the accounts A and B above referred to as
 the basis of his calculation after the amounts truly received
 have been paid by Spruvelly Williams administrator of Cardwell
 & Williams and Report to Court with any matters specially
 brought forward by himself or requested by the parties to be
 so stated
