of one hundred & sixty nine dollars and thirty cents with interest from the 30th
January 1849 till paid to Robert Dwyer or his assignor the sum of one
hundred dollars and thirty seven cents with interest from the 30th January 1849
till paid to Joseph & Robert Dwyer or their assignors the sum of eighty eight
dollars & fifty eight cents with interest from the 15th February 1849 till paid
to Cary Gay and Caroline Gay the sum of twenty one dollars and seventy
cents with interest from 30th January 1849 till paid: until to Joshua Dwyer
the sum of eight hundred and sixty one dollars and thirty seven cents with
interest in the hundred & eighty four dollars and thirty eight cents as past due
