This day the cause came on again to be heard at the papers
jointly read the Report of Commissioner Peckell and the state
was heard R: M. Consideration whereof the Court doth
adjudge order and decrees that William J. Peckell who is hereby
appointed special commissioner for that purpose, shall collect
the said bond of one hundred & four dollars and eighty eight
cents as soon as it may be done, and that he pay to Joseph
Wardens Sheriff & Committee of Benjamin Saml. decd. the sum
of twenty eight dollars and twenty nine cents with interest
from the 29th day of December 1848. to Peter Edwards the
sum of eighteen dollars and sixty six cents with interest from
the 29th of December 1848. To James Lockhart the sum of
twenty four dollars and fifty three cents with interest from
the 29th of December 1848. To Henry Henderson the sum
of twelve dollars and thirty three cents To John S. Barham
the sum of sixteen dollars & forty nine cents: and that he
Report to the Court in order to a final decree: But this
decree is to be of no effect until the said Peckell shall
enter into bond with security in the Clerk's office of
the Court conditioned according to Law in the penalty of
three hundred Dollars.

This cause the day came on again to be heard at the papers
jointly read together with the Report of Commissioner Truman
Bright and Henry Wade pursuant to the order of last Term
1848 to which no exception has been filed: And was argued
by Counsel: M. Consideration whereof the Court confirming
said Report doth order adjudge, and decrees that John Ed
Rockwell pay unto the said Martha B. Rockwell the sum
of fifteen dollars and fifty two cents with interest from
the day here paid: and the said John Tyler pay unto
the said Martha B. Rockwell the same amount with like
interest and that each party respectively pay his own cost
incurred since the order of November Term 1847.
