This day this cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read and on the Report of Commissioners Deane made in obedience to the doctral order of the Court at May Term 1849 and the Court confirming said Report to which there is no exception, and being of opinion that James W. Cooper attained his full age on the month of January 1849 doth adjudge order and decree that John J. Mason Executor of the last Will and Testament of Richard A. Williams decd. pay to James W. Cooper the sum of twenty one hundred and eighty four dollars & twelve cents with interest thereon from February 1. 1849. subject to a credit of one hundred & fifty dollars paid 12th April 1849 in part satisfaction of a legacy from Joseph S. Williams to the said Cooper and the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that Thomas B. Powell administrator defendant with the Willamson of Richard A. Williams decd. pay to the said James W. Cooper the sum of Eighteen hundred & fifty dollars & eight cents with interest thereon from the first day of February 1849 here paid in full satisfaction of his legacy from Joseph S. Williams decd. But the said Cooper is not to have the benefit of that decree till he or some one for him shall receive the legal & security to John J. Mason & Thomas B. Powell respectively in private double
