

The amount directed to be paid to him by each of whom com-
mitted to refund his proportion of any debt or debts which
may hereafter appear to be due against the Estate of Rich^d
Williams and the cost of such recovery: AND the Court
doth further adjudge order and decree that John & Isaac
pay to Row P. Williams the sum of one hundred & sixty eight
dollars & sixty two cents with interest from January 1st 1749
to be paid; and to Joseph Williams the sum of one hundred
& sixty dollars and ninety eight cents with like interest: in full satis-
faction of the hire of their slaves for the year 1748: and the Court
doth order & decree that Thomas B. Powell out of the estate of
Richard A. Williams estate pay the Plaintiff his costs by him
expended in this suit:

This cause came on the day to be again heard at the papers formerly
read and at the Report of said Judge by Commissioners Crump under
the decretall order bearing of 18th November 1748 and on the reformed
Report of Commissioners Frederick Taylor and returned to Court under
the same order and on the several exceptions filed to the said Reports
& was argued by Counsel on Consideration whereof the Court doth
confirm the said sale of land made by Commissioners Crump as therein
by his Report but as he has not stated in his Report how he has repaid
said the sum of one hundred and sixty four dollars and ninety three
cents retained by him out of the sale for the expence of sale he is
hereby required to Report specially to the Court an account of his
disbursement of the said sum: and as the Motion of the Plaintiff
by their attorney the Court doth adjudge order and decree that the
Account last Reported by Commissioners Frederick Taylor and
actions of Wm A. Sparks decd as Executor of Clement Rochelle decd be
recommended to the same Commissioners with instructions to examine partic-
ularly the items & other matters of the said account which are objected
to & Report the result of his enquire to the Court together with the
evidence touching the same in order that the Court may the better
decide upon the said exceptions: and the Court doth further adjudge
order and decree that Suzanne Taylor Attorney for the specially
creditors of Clement Rochelle decd who have proved their claims
before the Commissioners in this cause receive from the Clerk of the
Court who is required to deliver them to him upon executing his
Receipt for the said Bond returned by Commissioners Crump with
his Report of sale a sum in number and amounting to twenty
six hundred & twenty two dollars & twenty cents being in full of Bond
of Robt Bond & others for four hundred and two dollars & also for
one hundred and sixty seven dollars & twenty five cents the Bond
