This day the cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read to the Report of Commissioner Leudwyg made pursuant to the order of November Term 1848. to which there is no exception & the court confirming the same doth order & decree that unless the defendants James M. Draygo & Wm. Draygo or agents for them or before the 1st day of April next, pay to John M. Surley the sum of twenty five dollars with interest from November 1st 1847 to James M. Draygo ten hundred and twenty six dollars & fifty cents with interest from March 15th 1847 to John M. Surley one hundred & fifty six dollars & nine cents with interest from January 20th 1849 to James M. Draygo twenty five dollars & eighty cents with interest from April 20th 1848. To same fifty seven dollars & fifty one cent with interest from June 18th 1848 to same one hundred & twenty eight dollars and sixty cents with interest from January 23rd 1848. To same thirty two dollars & seventy cents with interest from January 3rd 1848 to same Eighty one dollars & thirty cents with interest from August 23rd 1848. To same five hundred & twenty five dollars with interest from August 1st 1847. To Thomas D. Ripley fifty dollars with interest from December 31 1847. To Daniel & Surley six dollars & seventy five cents with interest from February 10th 1848 to John M. Surley sixty three dollars & seventy three cents with interest from September 1st 1848. To James M. Draygo one hundred & fifty seven dollars & seventy five cents with interest from January 20th 1848. To J. J. Mason one hundred & eighty two dollars and thirty cents with interest on one hundred & twenty one dollars & fifty three cents part thereof from June 20th 1847. to favor William Surley one dollar eighty seven cents with interest on fifty five dollars part thereof from April 20th 1848. That John M. Surley who is hereby appointed Commissioner for that purpose shall after having given twenty days public notice of the time and place of sale sell to the highest bidder at the Court house of Washington County on said Court day the land in the proceedings mentioned whosoever it be. Draygo's doth assign, on a credit of twelve months except so much in Cash as will be necessary to pay the expenses of said & the cost of the suit & for the proceeds of sale after deducting the expenses thereof & of this and he take bond with good security & Report his proceedings to Court in order to a final decree. But the said Commissioner shall have no power to sell under this decree until he shall have filed in the Clerk's office of this Court bond with good security payable to the Commissioners of Virginia in a sum of two thousand dollars.
