This day the cause came on again to be heard at the papers formerly read in the cause, and was argued by counsel: On Consideration whereof the Court confirming the same doth adjudge order and decree that William & Thomas Commissioners be required to draw from the papers in the cause, and collect the same when due the 3rd and last bond for the sale of Allens quarter amounting to Three Thousand two hundred dollars due on the 15th January 1850, by John B. Jenkins, A. R. Dickie and James Jenkins And that from this amount they pay over to Amos A. Bryden or her assignee, one thousand sixty six dollars and sixty six cents being one third her portion of the same, that they indet five hundred and thirty three dollars and three cents in Virginia state stock, in the name of Mary M. Orgain as one of the daws of C. H. Collier: five hundred and thirty three dollars and three cents in same stock in the name of Elizabeth Carter Orgain; do as aforesaid: Three hundred and fifty five dollars and fifty five cents in same stock, in the name of Mary M. Orgain it being her share derived from her father R. B. Orgain And three hundred and fifty five dollars and fifty five cents, in same stock in the name of Elizabeth Carter Orgain her share of same from R. B. Orgain decd: and three hundred and fifty five dollars and fifty five cents, in same stock in the name of William Albert Orgain, it being his portion of the same derived from R. B. Orgain decd. And that the said Commissioners be required by this order to file the certificates of stock, aforesaid belonging to Mary M., Elizabeth Carter and William Albert Orgain among the papers of this cause; and Report the same with any other matters deemed pertinent there; And the Court doth further direct that the said Commissioners, John & Thomas upon the payment of the aforesaid bond of Thirty two hundred dollars due 15th January 1850 be aforesaid do receive unto the purchasers aforesaid all proceeds for the tract of land called paper swamp or Allens quarter in the proceeding mentioned: and this cause as to all other matters is continued
