This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and the report of Commissioner Cobb made pursuant to the order of November Term 1829 to which report there was no exception, and the Court concurring the said debt adjudged, order and decree, that myself the defendant Elizabeth Snyder, Joseph Snyder, Allen Snyder, Stevenson Snyder, Jane Snyder and Jane M. Snyder or some one for them before the expiration of sixty days shall pay to William Marshall the sum of thirty nine dollars and eighty six cents with interest from the 25th of January 1825 and to Charles L Coote the sum of fifty two dollars and eighty one cents with interest from the 25th of April 1829 then Alexander Myrick the Sheriff who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner for that purpose, shall after having given twenty days notice of the time and place of sale, sell to the highest bidder at the Courthouse of Southampton County one acre tenth day the land in the proceedings mentioned whereof Thomas Snyder died seized, possession to be delivered on the first of January next, on a credit of six months, except so much in cash as will be necessary to pay the expenses of sale and costs of this suit, and for the proceeds of sale after deducting the expenses thereof and of this suit, to take a bond with good security.
