Upon the petition of John D. Mines Guardian of Joseph I. It is further ordered that the said Executors pay to the said John D. Mines as guardian as aforesaid whatever may be in their hands to which Joseph I. Ricks may be entitled. But before the said Mines shall receive the amount due his Ward from the said Executors, he shall execute to the Executors proper refunding bond conditioned according to law.
