Organ, cash, the sum of twenty dollars and thirty cents with interest from this day till paid. That the Clerk of this Court in like manner deliver to Elizabeth Carter Organ Certificate of State Stock number seven hundred and seventy eight and Certificate of the Mechanics Savings Society of Petersburg, number four thousand and five which said Certificates are mentioned in Statement X. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that Certificates of State Stock number two hundred and seventy seven dated 27th January 1848 for eight hundred dollars and number seven hundred and seventy nine dated 12th February 1850, for eight hundred dollars invested in the name of Mary M. Organ and Certificates of State Stock number two hundred and seventy eight dated 27th Jan'y 1848 for eight hundred dollars and number seven hundred and twenty four dated 26th April 1849, for eight hundred dollars invested in the name of Elizabeth Carter Organ referred to in Statement X, do remain in the papers in this cause, under the control of this Court, subject to the limitations of the Will of C. H. Coler according to the act of assembly under which the land in the proceedings mentioned was sold. But the said Elizabeth C. Organ and the said Mary M. Organ or her guardian are hereby authorized to collect the interest on said Certificates of State Stock as the same falls due. And as to all other matters this cause is continued

This cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that a Commissioner of this Court ascertain and report to this Court, whether a bond executed for William Whiting and Catharine Prepon on the 1st day of January 1844, payable on demand after date to Joseph G. Cornwell and by him assigned to Monroe Clements and secured by a Deed of Trust bearing date 17th August 1844, was a joint bond of the said obligors or whether Wm Whiting was principal and Catharine Prepon his surety thereon; and also what amount or sum was advanced or paid on the said bond by Nancy Whiting on the 21st December 1847, to Monroe Clements or his agent and report the same to Court with any other matters deemed pertinent or required by the parties in order to a further decree in the premises. In taking which said account the parties are to submit to be examined in solemn form on oath before the Commissioner. Finding the said matter of account.
