The Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery held for Southampton County on the tenth day of November 1856 in a suit in which the appellee was plaintiff and the appellants defendant -

This day come the parties by their Counsel and the Court having maturely considered the transcript of the record of the decree aforesaid and the arguments of Counsel is of opinion that there is no error in the said decree; therefore it is decreed and ordered that the same be affirmed; and the appellants out of the costs of their defendant in these bonds to be administered do pay unto the appellee her costs before about her defense on this behalf expended; which is ordered to be certified to the Circuit Court of Southampton County -
