This cause came on this day to be heard on the Bill Answers of the defendants replications thereto, and the examination of witnesses and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that Richard A. Sumner, in which deed of conveyance, the said Louisa Murgahart widow of the late James Murgahart is directed to unite, conveying only interest which she may have at Law, in the same, but the execution and delivery of the said deed to the said Nancy E. Taylor is to be suspended until the said plaintiffs or some one of them as a consideration for the said lands, pay to Richard A. Murgahart & Charles F. Murgahart Executors of James B. Murgahart dec'd in each or in the last of the said James B. Murgahart the said sum of two hundred and eighty dollars, and the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that each party pay his own costs of this case.
