John A. Ogden and John A. Elder, Executors of C. H. Elder's Will.

The Plaintiff Mary M. Ogden having attained the age of twenty one years since the last term of this Court, this suit will hereafter proceed in her name, and thereupon this cause came on this day to be again heard on the papers formerly read and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth adjudge order and decree that the Clerk of this Court deliver to Mary M. Ogden a Certificate of State Stock No. 709 dated 9th March 1849 for \$500. and Certificate of State Stock No. 711. dated 14th March 1849 for \$500.00 and certificate of deposits from Mechanics Savings Society of Petersburg for \$209.34. No 2856 & dated 23rd August 1848, which said several certificates belong to the said Mary M. Ogden by the decree of November Term 1850 and statement I refer to in said decree. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that the certificates of State Stock of Virginia No. 277 dated 27th January 1848 for \$800. and No. 779 dated 12th February 1850, invested in the name of Mary M. Ogden, being her part of the proceeds of the interest of C. H. Elder's real estate in the proceedings mentioned, remain in the papers in this cause, under the control of this Court subject to the limitations of the will of C. H. Elder and according to the provisions of the act of Assembly under which the said real estate was sold. And the said Mary M. Ogden shall be at liberty, and she is hereby expressly authorized to collect the interest already due or which may hereafter become due during No. 779. And the Court doth in like manner adjudge, order and decree that the certificates of State Stock of Virginia No. 278, date 27th January 1848, for \$800. and No. 724 date
