

Counsel: On consideration whereof the Court confirming said reports, but without deciding the question as to the title of the above land and claimed by George C. Crump as mentioned in the said report of Commissioner Gordon, the said matter not being properly presented for decision by the pleadings in the cause doth adjudge order and decree that the Clerk of this Court deliver to Ingevell Taylor, the Receiver in this cause the bond of John M. Curley filed with the report of Commissioner Crump mentioned herein (upon his executing a receipt therefor) who is hereby authorized to collect the same and as Commissioner of this Court hereby specially appointed for that purpose to execute and deliver to the said Curley upon the payment of his said bond, a good and sufficient deed for the real premises purchased by him as appearing from said report of sale. And the said Receiver is also authorized to collect from the defendant Richard Abrams administrator of the said Clement Rockelle deceased the sum of \$263.25 with interest thereon from the 3<sup>rd</sup> December 1850 but said being the balance shown by report of Commissioner Gordon therein mentioned to be due from him, which he hath by law to pay to the said Receiver, and he will also pay over to the said Receiver the amount ~~without~~ decreed in this cause to be paid him by John M. Curley Exor of W<sup>m</sup> A. Spear dec<sup>d</sup> which has been collected by him after deducting his commissions and other charges of administration, instead of his retaining the balance among the creditors of Clement Rockelle named in the decree last referred to bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> November 1850, and will also pay to said Receiver the sum of \$29.99 the balance in his hands received from the sales of the real estate as shown by his said report herein mentioned. Which said sums of money hereby decreed to be collected by the said Receiver, he will after deducting his commissions and other proper charges apply to the payment of the remaining costs of this suit and of the balance remaining due to the creditors of Clement Rockelle dec<sup>d</sup> whose claims have been decreed to be paid out of the former collections by the said Receiver, who will then lay before a Commissioner of this Court a statement of his collections and payments as Receiver in this cause to be settled and adjusted by said Commissioner and returned to Court by him, and he will deposit whatever balance of any may then be in his hands as Receiver in the Norfolk Savings Institution subject to the future order of this Court in this cause. And the said Ingevell Taylor before he shall be authorized to collect the moneys mentioned in this decree shall execute in the Clerk's office a Bond as Receiver with good security in the penalty of \$1500. conditioned according to Law.
