decreeal order issued at the last term, and with petition of Wm. A. Draper,
Jury and witness. This day filed by leave of the Court answers
argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court confirming said
report with adjudge, order and decree that the defendant John Moore
who is hereby appointed a special Commissioner for that purpose sell at
public auction after giving notice of the time and place of sale
at the Court house of the said County and at two or more public
places also of the said County in a space of six months the land
and slaves mentioned in the Bill, that is to say, the tract of land
conveyed to the said John Moore as Trustee by the deed of Howell
& wife in the proceedings mentioned, described in said deed as a tract
in the County of Southampton, known as the old Place, containing
about one hundred and twenty acres more or less, adjoining the lands
of Elizabeth Johnson & others, and negro woman Cissy and her
three children and her increase since (if any), taking from the
purchasers so much cash as will pay the expenses of sale,
and for the remainder bonds with good security, payable to
the said Commissioner in six months and bearing interest from
the day of sale, which bonds with the report of sale he
will return to the Court, & will retain the title to the land
until the further order of the Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Monday morning next in October
