Waller pay to the Plaintiff the said sums, interest and costs out of the amount reported to be in his hands, but the Plaintiff is not to have the benefit of this decree unless he or some one for him shall have entered into bond in the Clerk's Office of this Court, with security in aforesaid of double the amount decreed to be paid # Conditioned according to Law.
