Harrison \$18.30 per with interest on \$18. from December 25th 1848, to Robert Howland \$17.30 with interest on \$17. - from March 30. 1850, to W^m D. Taylor some \$114.26 with interest on \$114.23 from Jan^y 1. 1849, to Lewis J. Parker \$233.11 with interest on \$233.75 from August 13. 1845, to Isaac S. Barkham \$13.28 with interest on \$12.78 from January 1. 1851, to John A. Cotton \$40. with interest thereon from December 25th 1847, to A. B. Scarborough \$9.07 with interest from October 7th 1848, to R. J. Simmons \$9.26 with interest from July 17th 1848, to W^m J. Goodwyn \$39.26 with interest on \$33.12 from 20th September 1849, and the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that a Commissioner of this Court ascertain and report the balance which will remain in the said Mangum's hands after paying the sums above specified, the amounts still outstanding against the estate of John S. P. Pennington and the amount to which each of said debts may be entitled to receive from the balance in Mangum's hands. The Commissioner will report to this Court in order to a final decree.
