This day this cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly read on the report of the commissioner made in pursuance of an order of this Court entered at November Term 1857, to which report there is no exception, and the Court confirming report as the adjudge, order and decree that the defendant Benjamin Ellis pay to the plaintiff fifteen dollars with interest thereon from 1st day of January 1853 till paid, and the Court with further adjudge, order and decree by consent of the plaintiff that Col. W. Mendenhall who is appointed a commissioner for the purpose after advertising the time and place of sale, at the Court House door of South Ambler County and at two or more places in the neighborhood of the Land, sell at public auction to the highest bidder on a credit of Twelve months except cash sufficient to defray the expense of sale, the land in the proceedings mentioned, that he take of the purchaser two bonds with good security of equal amounts for the purchase money, and pay over one of said bonds to John R. Williams attorney of Evelina Williams and the other to the said Williams attorney of Louisa Williams. The Commissioner will make a deed to the purchaser of the Land and report his proceedings to Court. It is ordered that each of the parties pay their own costs.
