This day this cause came on to be again heard on the papers formerly
read and on the report of the commissioner made in pursuance of an order of
this court entered at November term 1857, to which report there
is no exception, and the Court confirming the report doth adjudge, award
and decree that the defendant Benjamin Eliza pay to the plaintiff
fifteen dollars with interest thereon from 1st day of January
1852 till paid, and the Court doth further adjudge, order
and decree by consent of the plaintiff that C. W. Moseley
who is appointed a commissioner for the purpose after ascertaining
the time and place of sale, at the Courthouse door of South
Carolina County and at two or more places in the neighbourhood
of the Law, sell at public auction to the highest bidder in a
credit of twelve months except cost sufficient to defray the
expenses of sale, the land in the proceedings mentioned,
that he take of the purchaser two lots with good security
of equal amounts for the purchase money, and pay over one
of said lots to John R. Williams attorney of Caroline Williams
and the other to the said Williams attorney of Louisa Williams.
The Commissioner will make a deed to the purchaser of the
land and report his proceedings to court. It is ordered that
each of the parties pay their own costs.
