It appearing to the Court that since the last hearing of this
cause the complainant Joseph J. Richards has attained lawful age, on
motion of counsel it is ordered that the further proceedings in the
cause be conducted in his own proper name, and it being
suggested that the plaintiff Rebecca Ann Sunday has intermar-
ried with Seth C. Turner, it is ordered that the suit be
revised and prosecuted in the name of said Seth C. Turner &
wife, and therefore the cause come on again to be heard on the
papers formerly read together with the report of Commissioner
Bordogni made pursuant to the order of November Term 1851, to
which no exception has been filed and was argued by counsel.
On consideration whereof, the Court confirming said report with order,
adjudge & decree that Joseph H. Prince Exor. of Benj. Williamson
do pay to Howell Harris guardian of Henry S. Jones the sum
of \$4.00. with interest from the 31st Dec. 1851, to William A. Jones
guardian of the children of Rebecca Jane Jones, the sum of \$353.45.
with interest thereon from the 11th September 1853, to Seth C. Turner
and his wife Rebecca Ann the sum of \$136.15. with like interest.
to Robert W. Richards the sum of \$303.35. with like interest. to Joseph J.
Richards the sum of \$176.12. with like interest, that said executor
return in his hands and hold in trust the sum of \$337.15 due the
infant Alfred Sunday pursuant to the will of his testator, and that
John Keigzard pay to the said Prince the sum of \$103.58 with inter-
est from the 11th September 1853, that Edwin C. Blend Exor. of
Benj. Williamson pay to Joseph J. Richards the sum of \$1086.
70 with int. thereon from the 5th August 1853, to Robert
W. Richards the sum of \$1103.07 with interest from the 1st May
1853, to John Keigzard in right of his wife Martha the sum of
\$337.35 with like interest, to Seth C. Turner and his wife Rebecca
Ann the sum of \$335.38 with like interest, and that said executor return in
his hands and hold in trust the sum of \$735.38 with like interest
due the infant Alfred Sunday pursuant to the directions in the will
of his testator. And the Court doth further order that each of the said parties
above named together with Thorpe & Adams legates under the will of the
said Benj. Williamson a sum one for them, accrete to the said executor
respectively bonds with good security in a specialty equal to the amount
incurred by them respectively, conditioned to refund them due proportion of
any debt or demand which may hereafter come against the estate of said
Williamson. And that the defendant Joe H. Prince & Exor. pay the
incertified costs of this suit, out of the amount returned in his hands
as stated in the Commissioner's report, and pay over the balance to
the residuary legates pro rata.
