Trader by her Guardian ad litem, the replications to the said answers, and the examinations of witnesses and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof it appearing to the Court that the interest of the infant defendants will be promoted by the sale of the land in the proceedings mentioned, and the rights of no person be violated thereby, the Court doth assign, order and decree that George W. Dute, William H. Dutton and Benjamin T. Smith, any two of whom may act, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose, make sale of the said land after posting notice of the time place of sale on the Courtroom door of Southampton County in a Court day preceding the sale, and also at one or more places in the neighborhood and advertising same for four weeks in some newspaper published in the County of Norfolk or Stafford, on the premises, at public auction to the highest bidder on a credit of six and two years in equal instalments unless the same can be sold
