This day this cause came on to be heard on the papers formerly read, and on the report of Commissioner Turner made in pursuance of a decree rendered in this cause at November Term 1852 to which report there is no exception and the court confirming the same doth adjudge order and decree that Edward P. Turner guardian to Edmund J. Turner receive from the Clerk of this Court who is hereby required to deliver the same, the bonds returned with said report executed by Thomas B. Trevall and Joseph T. Trevall for the sum of five hundred dollars each dated 1st day of December 1852 one due six months after date and the other twelve months after date and when due collect the same and pay the costs of this suit and expenses of sale and loan out the balance on bond with good security real or personal, or invest it in Bank Stock bearing six percent interest. And the Court doth further adjudge order and decree that on the payment of the said bonds the said Commissioner shall execute a deed to the said Purchaser for the said land with special warranty. But the said Turner shall not execute any portion of this decree until he enters into bond with good security in the Clerks Office of this Court payable to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned according to law.
