Thomas and Nathaniel Francis who are hereby appointed Commissioners for that purpose, and any two of whom may act, shall divide the following slaves belonging to the estate of Nathaniel Francis dec'd and those two or any of the females herein named since the Commissioners report to wit, Harry, Maria, Catherine, Charlotte, Matilda, George, Sol, Elbridge, Henry, Cesar, Lucy, David, Amy and child, Fugitive, Bridget, Andrew, Sarah, Bob, Amaca and children, Violet, Otto, and his children, Eveline, Washington, Frank, Charles, Jerry, and child and Henry (litle) Ben and Bette considered as one - that the said Commissioners divide the aforesaid slaves and increase, if any, into eight equal shares in value, taking the Commissioners valuation thereof as a Standard and allot one eighth in value to Albert Francis the posthumous child and of the remaining seven eights allot one eighth to William Francis, allot one eighth to John H. Francis, allot one eighth to Andrew O. Francis, one eighth to Elizabeth Francis, allot one eighth to Nathaniel Francis, allot one eighth to Martha Jane Francis and allot one eighth to Anna Eliza Francis - And that the said Commissioners make report to the Court in order to a final decree -

2<sup>nd</sup> an account of the amounts due on the complainants judgments and that of Timothy C. Atkinson against Joshua Proffit in the proceedings mentioned constituting a bill on the property conveyed by said deed and of any other bills thereon with the respective order of the same and make report thereof to Court with any matters deemed pertinent by himself or required by the parties to be stated - and the said Commissioner is hereby authorized, if required by any of the parties to do so, to summon before him any of the parties and examine him on oath touching the matter in controversy - The Commissioner shall give notice of the time and place of taking, by advertisement once a week for four successive weeks in the Southern Argus, a newspaper published in the City of Norfolk and at the Court house door of Southampton County and such notice shall be equivalent to personal service of such notice on the parties and persons interested in taking the same -
