This cause came on this day to be again heard upon the papers
formerly read: the report of Commissioner Goodwyn made pursuant to
the order of May 1853, to which there is no excep-
tion, and by consent of the plaintiffs by their counsel and the defend-
ant Ricks, the court doth adjudge, order and decree that the said
defendant pay unto the plaintiff Tomlin in right of his wife Marga-
ret the sum of \$395.43 with interest on \$285.71 from 14th May 1850
until paid, to George Winston the sum of \$395.43 with interest on \$285
thru part thereof from 14th May 1850, to James Winston Junr, the
like sum of \$395.43 with interest on \$285.71 part thereof from said
14th May 1850 till paid to Robert H. Wilson in right of his
wife Ann P. formerly Winston the like sum of \$395.43 with
interest on \$285.71 part thereof from 14th May 1850 subject
to a credit of \$300 paid on 5th May 1852, to Eliza Cornelia
Winston, Virginia Henry Winston & to William Winston
each the sum of \$395.43 with interest on \$285.71 part thereof
from 14th May 1850 till paid and that the defendant pay
the costs of this suit.

decreeal order herein of May Term 1853, to which report no exception
has been filed & the Court confirming the same doth adjudge, order &
decree that unless the defendant Joshua Prefen or John E. Prefen
or some one for them or on their behalf the 15th day of December next
pay to Samuel H. Holmes & M. Bailey & others the sum of \$36.33 with interest thereon from May
20th 1849, to John Hargrave \$85.78 with interest on \$64.87 part
thereof from March 15th 1851, to A. Atkinson Exor of Jas. Chalmers
dec'd \$71.22, with interest thereon from March 14th 1851, the Sheriff of
this county sell on the premises conveyed by Joshua Prefen to John Hargrave
at Public Auction to the highest bidder for cash the negro man Nelson,
Horse, stock of cattle, Hogs, sheep, household & kitchen furniture in the
proceedings mentioned conveyed by the deed of trust from Joshua Prefen
to Samuel H. Holmes for the benefit of M. Bailey & others pay-
ed by the said Joshua Prefen to John E. Prefen by a deed bearing
date the 2nd day of Feb'y 1853, after having given thirty days notice
of the time & place of sale by advertisement let the Court-house door
