The bill of the plaintiff having been taken for confedered at rule no
the defendants Hawkins & Son, Phillips Linn, summing cause of Richard
A. Kelly, Emma Evans, Eleanor Evans and Sarah A. Jenkins and
his wife Margaret, and it appearing to the Court that the plaintiff
has proceeded in the mode prescribed by Law against absent
defendants, as to the defendants S. M. Pond, William Evans, R. G.
Laurant and his wife Ann, and W. William Galloway and his wife Martha
who still fail to appear and answer, on motion the bill is taken
for confedered as to those defendants, and the cause coming on to
be heard on the bill, answer of the defendant Kelly, sheriff of John
Evans, replication to said answer and exhibits, was argued by Counsel.
On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree
that a commissioners of this Court take an account of the trans-
actions of John Evans, as executor of Rebecca Evans d^r and
that said Commissioners take there account filed in this cause marked
(B) as the basis of such settlement liable to be discharged and
falsified by either of the parties - that said Commissioner also take
an account between the said John Evans, exec'r and each of the legatees
under the will of the said Rebecca Evans so as to show whether the
female legatees under the will of the Rebecca Evans have attained the
age of eighteen years and the male legatees the age of twenty one
years and what amount is due each one of said legatees and that
the auditor state and report to Court said accounts together with
any matter specially stated demand pertinent by himself or
required to be so stated by either of the parties. And the Court
doth further order that notice of the time and place of taking the
accounts above mentioned be published once a week for four weeks
successively in some newspaper in the town of Peterburg, and that
such publication be equivalent to personal service of such
notice on the parties.
