Cobb is directed to report his proceedings to the Court in order to a further decree. and the Court doth further adjudge and decree that Sam'l Helle exec. of Lewis Allmond dec'd. settle his transaction as administrator before a Commissioner of this court who is also directed settle the accounts of Lucy Allmond as acting guardian of the distributions of Lewis Allmond dec'd. and report the said accounts together with any matter stated deemed pertinent by himself as required to be stated by any of the parties.
