 appointed for that purpose and was argued by Counsel. On
 consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree
 that William W. Cobb who is hereby appointed special Commissioner
 for that purpose, shall after having given twenty days notice
 of the sale by public advertisement at the Courthouse and such
 other public places as he may think best, on the land whereof
 Lewis Allmond died seized and perfected proceed to sell at
 public auction to the highest bidder the tract of land and slave
 belonging to the estate of Lewis Allmond dec^d with following
 land, Part: sufficient of the purchase money in cash to defray the
 costs of this suit and the expenses of the sale, the residue in a
 credit of nine months, and take from the purchaser or purchasers
 bonds with good and sufficient security payable to himself as
 Commissioner, and the title to the land to be reserved until the
 purchase money shall have been paid and the said William
 W. Cobb is directed to report his proceedings thereunto
 in order to a further decree. and the Court doth further adjudge
 order and decree that Saml. Hells adm^r of Lewis Allmond dec^d,
 settle his transactions as administrator before a Commissioner of his Court
 who is also directed settle the accounts of Mary Allmond as acting
 guardian of the distributions of Lewis Allmond dec^d and report the said
 accounts together with any matters stated deemed pertinent by himself or
 so required to be stated by any of the parties.
