This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read together with the report of
Commissioner Woodward made pursuant to the order of May Term 1854, to which no exceptions have
been filed and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court confirming said report,
doth adjudge, order and decree that Samuel Wells administrator of John Exum out of the assets of
his intestate, Shugars Lane pursuing administrator of Richard A Wells out of the assets of his
intestate, Samuel M Pond and Hawkins Pond, pay to the plaintiff Robert P Stephenson the sum
of two hundred and sixty two dollars and sixty two cents with interest thereon from the 8th day of
November 1849 till paid, together with the costs of this suit. But this decree is without prejudice
to the rights of the defendants William Exum, R. C. Cawcutt and wife and William Callaway & wife
who may hereafter assert their rights.
