Francis the sum of \$787.23 etc with interest on \$422.01 etc from the 31st of Decr. 1853, and interest on the residue of \$368.22 etc from the 31st Decr. 1854, that they pay to the lawful guardian of Elizabeth Francis the sum of \$1059.01 etc with interest on \$422.01 etc from the 31st of Decr. 1853, and interest on the residue of \$637.03 etc from the 31st of Decr. 1854, that they pay to the lawful guardian of Andrew J. Francis the sum of \$1063.06 etc with interest on \$422.01 etc from the 31st of Decr. 1853, and interest on the residue of \$640.03 etc from the 31st of Decr. 1854, that they pay to the lawful guardian of Albert Francis the sum of \$919.18 etc with interest on \$279.15 etc from the 31st of Decr. 1853, and interest on the residue of \$640.03 etc from the 31st of Decr. 1854, and that they pay to Lavinia Francis the sum of \$1116.61 etc with interest from the 31st of Decr. 1853, and the Commissioner doth further adjudge, order and decree that the lawful guardians of the infants Elizabeth, Martha Jane and Anne Eliz.
