be re-arrested and process issued in his name, and the bill of the complainant
having been taken for confessing at the rules as to all the
defendants and they still failing to appear and answer the cause
come on to be heard on the bill and exhibits therewith filed and
was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court
doth adjudge, order and decree that the Sheriff of Southampton
County, after giving at least twenty days notice of the time and place
of sale by public advertisement at the Courthouse of said County, and at
other public places in the neighborhood of said land, sell to the highest
bidder for each on the premises, the tract of land containing forty
two and a half acres conveyed by James Buttle by deed of trust bearing
date the 1st day of March 1833, and duly admitted to record in the
Deeds Office of Southampton County Court on the 20th day of
May 1833, to John L. Warren trustee, to secure the sum of
\$200-- due from the said James Buttle to Lewis N. Branch
by bond bearing date the 1st day of March 1833, and out
of the proceeds of said sale after paying the expenses of this decree
(and said sale pay to W^m. W. Cobb, attorney to bonis non of Lewis N.
Branch dec'd. the sum of \$200-- with interest thereon from the 1st
day of March 1833, and the balance if any to Samuel Kello
Shuff and executors of James Buttle dec'd and make report thereof
to this Court in order to a final decree. And the Court doth
further order that the said Sheriff upon payment of the purchase
money for said land shall execute a deed to the said purchaser
with special warranty.
