It being suggested that since the commencement of this suit, the plaintiff has departed this life, on motion of W^m. W. Cobb, adms^r to Lewis N. Branch dec^d it is ordered that the suit be revived and proceed in his name, and the bill of the complainant having been taken for confessed at the rules as to all the defendants and they still failing to appear and answer the cause come on to be heard on the bill and exhibits therewith filed and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the Sheriff of Southampton County, after giving at least twenty days notice of the time and place of public advertisement at the Court house of said County, and at other public places in the neighborhood of said land, sell to the highest bidder for cash on the premises, the tract of land containing sixty two and a half acres conveyed by James Ruttle of dec^d of last bearing date the 1st day of March 1833, and duly admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County Court on the 20th day of May 1833, to John L. Warren, Trustee, to secure the sum of \$200. - due from the said James Ruttle to Lewis N. Branch of bond bearing date the 1st day of March 1833, and out of the proceeds of said sale after paying the costs of this suit and the said sale pay to W^m. W. Cobb, adms^r de Lewis N. Branch dec^d the sum of \$200. - with interest thereon from the 1st day of March 1833, (and the balance if any to Samuel Kells Shiff and adms^r of James Ruttle dec^d and make report thereof to this Court in order to a final decree. And the Court doth further order that the said Sheriff upon payment of the purchase money for said land shall execute a deed to the said purchaser with especial warranty.
