

and the report of Commissioner Goodwyn made pursuant to order of May term 1844, and also a Special Statement showing the present value of Lucy Almond's interest in Lewis Almond's estate (and to which no exception has been filed) and the Court confirming the reports of Commissioner Cobb and Goodwyn together with the Special Statement in said Goodwyn's report as to Lucy Almond's present interest, doth adjudge, order and decree that Commissioner Cobb shall withdraw the bills filed in this cause from the office of the Clerk and collect the same when due and after paying the additional expense of this decree pay to Lucy Almond the sum of \$284.74 cents and divide the residue into six equal parts and allot one sixth to George Griffin and Louisa his wife, one sixth to Nathaniel Almond, - But the said Commissioner shall not proceed to act under this decree until he shall have executed into the Clerk's office of this Court bond with good and sufficient security in the penalty of \$1500. conditioned as the Law directs. And the Court doth further adjudge order and decree by the consent of Lucy Almond that out of the remaining five sixths the said Commissioner pay to her the sum of One hundred dollars and of the residue allot one sixth to the lawful guardian of Robert Almond, one sixth to the lawful guardian of William Almond, one sixth to the lawful guardian of Martha Almond one sixth to the lawful guardian of John Almond and report to the Court in order to official decree.

And the Court doth further order that the said defendant R. D. Waller Exr. of Levi McAllister do render before a Commissioner of this Court an account of his transactions as executor of Levi McAllister dec'd, and that said Commissioner audit, state, and report the same to Court with any matters especially stated deemed pertinent by himself or required to be so stated by either of the parties.
