

and the report of Commissioner Gordwyn made pursuant to order of May term 1851, and also a special statement showing the present value of Lucy Almond interest in Lewis Almond's estate (to which no objection has been filed) and the Court confirming the reports of Commissioners Cobb and Gordwyn together with the special statement in said Gordwyn's report as to Lucy Almond's present interest, both adjudge, order (and decree) that Commissioner Cobb shall withdraw the bonds filed in this cause from the office of the Clerk (and collect the same when due and after paying the additional expense of this cause) and to Lucy Almond the sum of \$284.79 cents, and divide the residue into six equal parts (and allot one sixth to George Buffin and Luisa his wife, one sixth to Nathaniel Almond. But the said Commissioner shall not proceed to act under this decree until he shall have executed with Clerk's office of this court bond with good and sufficient security in the penalty of \$1500 or conditioned by the Law directed. And the Court doth further adjudge order (and decree) by the consent of Lucy Almond that out of the remaining four sixths the said Commissioner pay to her the sum of One hundred dollars and of the residue allot one fourth to the lawful guardian of Robert Almond, one fourth to the lawful guardian of McAllister Almond, one fourth to the lawful guardian of Martha Almond one fourth to the lawful guardian of John Almond and report to the Court in order to a final decree.
