Washington dec'd pay to Benjamin B. Washington administrator of Biggy Washington dec'd the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars thirty three cents with interest thereon from December 31st 1854 till paid. To Arthur A. Downey administrator of Nancy Hancock dec'd the like amount with like interest. To Joseph and John R. Briggs administrators of William Briggs dec'd eleven hundred and eighty seven dollars six cents with like interest. To Arthur A. Downey administrator of David Cook dec'd one hundred and eighty one dollars twenty two cents with like interest. To John Stephenson and Elizabeth his wife the like amount with like interest. To Benjamin B. Washington sixty dollars forty three cents with like interest and to Calvin J. Stephenson administrator of Stephen Washington the like sum with like interest. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that each party pay the costs by him expended in this suit.
