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since this cause was heard and William J. Sebell having qualified as his (and
ministrate, or motion it is ordered that this suit proceed in the name of
the said (ministrate) and the cause came on to be further heard with
papers formerly read (and the report of Commissioner Collet made,
under a decree of the Court pronounced at May term 1851, and
the Court confirming said report to which no exceptions have been
filed, doth adjudge, order and decree that William J. Sebell
Executor of W. M. Sebell pay to the plaintiff \$137.27
with interest thereon from Decr 18th 1851, till paid.

And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that William
J. Sebell, Executor of W. M. Sebell render before a Com-
missioner of this Court a further account of his transactions
with the estate of his testator, who will report the same to
Court with any matters specially stated demanded pertinent
by himself or which may be required by either of the parties
to be so stated.

Richard Barrett in his own right & as Coor of Wm. Barrett Deft
against
Erastus R. Barrett & Edward C. Crumpler Deft.

This cause came on this day to be heard on the bill and Exhibits and on
the answers of the infant defendant Erastus R. Barrett filed at rules by
C. W. Masfrenburg his Guardian ad litem duly assigned to defend
him in this suit general replication to said answer and on the answer
of the defendant Edward C. Crumpler also filed at rules and as
argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court is of opinion
and doth adjudge and decree that the infant defendant Erastus R.
Barrett is entitled in fee to all the property real and personal
held and enjoyed during her life by Martha Matilda Crumpler
daughter of and devisee of Wm. Musfee, the testator in the preces-
sors mentioned under the second and sixth clauses of the will of said Wm.
Musfee referred to in the plaintiffs bill, viz. to the tract of land in the County
of Southampton described in and conveyed by the deed of Isaac Brown,
Simon Musfee and J. D. Masfrenburg to the said Martha M. Crumpler
subject to the limitations of the will of the said Wm. Musfee deceased
which said deed bears date the 29th March 1814, and an office
copy of which is filed as an exhibit marked C. with the bill and
also to another tract of land in said County described in and conveyed by
the deed of Isaac Brown and J. D. Masfrenburg to the said Martha
M. Crumpler subject to the limitations aforesaid which deed
bears date the 19th of April 1822, and an office copy of which
is filed as an exhibit marked D. with the bill and also to the
slaves, Anthony, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Richard, Gilda,
Gaugana, Susan, Sarah, Judith, Hannah, Alice, Abeline,
Vernon, Francis and Lucy mentioned in the bill and it is ordered
that the defendant Edward C. Crumpler deliver to the said
Erastus R. Barrett or his legal Guardian the said slaves and
surrender to him or his said Guardian possession of the said
lands.
